



MWHC Window Exhibit- Criteria for Selection and Agreements

- Each exhibit selected will have some connection to women in the arts, careers and some type of social engagement message. MWHC is a bipartisan nonprofit, so no political exhibits unless balanced historical exhibits.
- Artist and items reflect all types of Maryland's diversity.
- Window is approximately 7 'long and 24-36" deep.
- No cost to the selectee for the opportunity to exhibit their work.
- Approximately 1-2 months of display time base on mutual agreement.
- If the artist sells an item, MWHC would appreciate a % of the item sold as a donation to MWHC. Rate TBD
- Artist will also provide a short bio, contact information and other related information to also be included the window design/layout. (i.e., poster board or something to feature)
- Refer a friend /colleague to apply to be a MWHC window artist in the future.
- MWHC is **NOT** responsible for the artist's work. The artist must bring, install/layout and remove all items at the end of the display period.
- The artist will give permission for photographs of item in the window exhibit as well as for posting on social media.
